Internationalization of jobs in Tilburg







Students

- 1800 new international students to Tilburg University
 - 400 more than last year
 - Another growth of 400 expected next year
 - This excludes Fontys, Avans, etc.

Labor migrants

- At least 100.000 in Noord-Brabant
- Mainly eastern- and southern-Europese
- Mainly logistics, agriculture

Knowledge migrants

- At least 50.000 in Noord-Brabant (2015)
- Mainly working in technological companies


A public Dutch healthcare insurance is obligated

- · A student insurance will not suffice
- Costs range from €100,- to over €130,-
- You can assemble your own package (i.e. dental, physiotherapy, birth control)

A governmental healthcare subsidy is possible

- It is dependent on your income (€104 per month if you earn less than €20.000 per year) and living situation
- You'll need to be registered in the municipality, have a valid residence permit, have a public Dutch healthcare insurance and work






Public healthcare insurance when working

The Dutch payment structure


Gross income & net income

- ·Salary is based on the hours you work
- · Salary is initially expressed as gross income
- The net income is derived by deducting taxes from the gross income
- ·By paying taxes, you are possibly entitled for benefits by the state, such as a student loan and OV



Income tax

- •The lowest income-tax scale is 36,65% when earning < €20.385
- Loonheffingskorting: an income-tax deducting applies to your primary job
- Your employer pays the taxes for you, you'll receive your net income on your bank account
- Every year you will have to provide an income declaration with Belastingdienst
- · Your employer provides this information to Belastingdienst, you'll need to verify it





For EU students:

- Have one by default
- Can work as much or little as you want





For non-EU students:

- Employer needs to apply for a permit
- Permit will only be valid at said employer
- You can work a maximum of 16 hours per week or full-time in summer
- Application takes 2-5 weeks
- Application and permit is free



 Travel with a 40% discount during the other part of the week / off-peak hours




Student finance: supplementary grant

A governmental support for students

- · Based on your parents income
- · Based on Dutch income standards
- Get up to €396,39 = (€7,08 per hour when working 56 hours)
- Provide a lot of documents
- Gift if you finish your degree within 10 years


